The Market does not provide tables, chairs or marquees except as ad-hoc assistance, so please bring your own infrastructure. Your site, display and set up is your responsibility. A marquee is not required for attendance, but is generally necessary to maintain your stall in unexpected weather.

Please note that winds are not unusual, so please secure your marquee via weights or pegs or, preferably, both.

How many sites for your stall?

Stall fees are calculated from stall size. In the shed that is per standard table (1.8x0.76m) and in the open it is per standard marquee (3x3m). Fees are Single \$20, Double \$30 etc, with half sizes available.

Do you require a vehicle at the stall?
